NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Lake Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) that a Protest Hearing will be held on **Wednesday, September 16, 2026 at 9:30 a.m.** (or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard) in the Clearlake City Council Chambers at Clearlake City Hall located at 14050 Olympic Drive, Clearlake, CA 95422, to receive written protests filed against the **Scotts Valley Water Conservation District Dissolution** (File No. DIS-2026-01).

The County of Lake, acting on behalf of the District, approved Resolution No. 2025-131 on November 18, 2025 to initiate proceedings for dissolution of the Scotts Valley Water Conservation District (SVWCD or District) due to longstanding inactivity. The reason for the dissolution proposal is that SVWCD was formed in 1972 to conserve and enhance water resources in the Scotts Valley area, but has not provided services since its formation, has experienced difficulty maintaining a full Board of Directors, resulting in administrative inactivity, and lacks the capacity to fulfill its intended functions.

The Commission approved the dissolution on June 17, 2026 under Resolution No. 2026-03, which sets forth a full and complete description of the change of organization and the terms and conditions of approval. Landowners and registered voters within the Scotts Valley WCD may file a written protest against the dissolution. The Protest Form must be dated, signed, and received during the **Protest Period** to be considered, which begins on July 22, 2026 and ends on September 16, 2026, at the close of the Protest Hearing.

Written protests must either be mailed and received in advance of the hearing (not postmarked) to PO Box 348, Yuba City, CA 95992, or delivered to LAFCo staff at the protest hearing prior to the close of the hearing (email is not accepted). Written protests filed may also be withdrawn prior to the close of the hearing. The protest form and related documents are available on the LAFCo website (www.lakelafco.org/current-proposals).
