John:

I quickly reviewed this and have the following comments.

1. Page 23, #10-Kelsey Creek Detention Structure: This facility provides significant benefit to the Kelseyville potable water system (Kelseyville County Water Works District #3) by improving recharge for the systems' 4 groundwater wells. As a result, this budget contributes \$2,000 per year (budget unit 8593, Object Code 18-00, Maintenance, Buildings & Improvements) for the operation of that structure.

2. Page 26, Collaboration: Lake County Special Districts collaborates with the Department of Water Resources on a variety of projects. Examples include the one mentioned above, participation in IRWMP process, and a proposed Clear Lake Hitch fish ladder project on Seigler Creek. This also includes the Elem Tribe because the ladder is within their ancestral tribal territory.

In the future, I anticipate more involvement because I assume they will be the lead agency to implement the recent groundwater legislation referred to later in this document.
